# PROVIDING TREATMENT AND SUPPORT TO INDIVIDUALS LIVING IN STANISLAUS COUNTY WHO ARE EXPERIENCING AN ACUTE MENTAL HEALTH EMERGENCY

The Stanislaus County Psychiatric Health Facility (PHF) is an acute inpatient program licensed by the State of California for individuals experiencing an acute emergency related to a mental health disorder, where they can receive intensive mental health and psychiatric treatment services to assist in the stabilization of the episode. Services are provided by professional and paraprofessional staff as per licensing and certification requirements. Admission is voluntary or via 5150.

### STRUCTURE OF PROGRAM

- 16 bed
- Locked
- **1** 24/7/365
- 5 to 7 days average length of stay
- Voluntary and involuntary admissions

### SERVICES PROVIDED INCLUDE:

- Comprehensive evaluation and risk assessment
- Collaborative treatment planning with a recovery focus
- Crisis planning
- Supportive counseling on group and individual basis
- Medication evaluation and management
- Discharge planning, including linkage with community services and support

The program also provides involuntary services for individuals who require that level of support. Individuals who are at imminent risk of harm to self or others may be placed on an involuntary or "special care status." This is done to ensure their safety as well as the safety of others.

### STAFFING

The program is well-staffed. Licensed staff are available on every shift, including physicians, as well as registered nurses, licensed vocational nurses and licensed psychiatric social workers. Nursing and clinical care are provided around the clock.
