Required Hours for CC Deemed Trainings	Jennifer Baker	Looking at changes that are coming and would like feedback from the committee regarding how many required hours for cultural competency training deemed. Other counties deemed a certain amount of hours (3-6 hours) of training per year. How do we track ongoing trainings? Deeming so many hours for CC trainings, for example LGBTQ training, how many hours per year? Feedback: More hours the better, can we accommodate everybody? Designate which training would be used to fulfill cultural competency; when emailing staff, mark CC in parenthesis on the email so staff are aware. If this plan moves forward instead of the Brief Multi-cultural Scale Training it would be an introduction course to Cultural Competency, Equity and Social Justice discussing what our cultural competency plan is and what the CLAS Standards are.
