"Pursuant to the authority vested in the Board of Supervisors by California Government Code Title 3, Division 2, Chapter 1, Article 6, the Board of Supervisors may appoint a clerk of the Board of Supervisors to perform the duties set forth in Article 6, including supervising the general operations of the Board office and staff and such additional duties as the Board of Supervisors shall prescribe by ordinance."

This ordinance shall take effect 30 days from and after the date of its passage and before the expiration of 15 days after its passage it shall be published once, with the members voting for and against the same, in the Modesto Bee, a newspaper published in the County of Stanislaus, State of California.




