APPROVAL OF A CONTRACT AMENDMENT FOR THE FY 00-01 MULTIPURPOSE SENIOR SERVICES PROGRAM CONTRACT WITH THE CALIFORNIA DEPARTMENT OF AGING TO PROVIDE SUPPORTIVE SERVICES FOR FRAIL ELDERLY RESIDENTS OF OUR COUNTY.

DISCUSSION:

MSSP is a social/health case management program designed to prevent or delay institutional placement of the frail elderly and to provide for the return to the community of elderly persons already institutionalized. This is accomplished by assessment, regular contact and coordinated supervision by the Case Manager and MSSP Nurse. In addition, MSSP purchases an array of contracted services and equipment to insure client safety in their own home. Services include but not limited to: personal care, chore services, respite care for the live-in care takers, adult day care and communication services for clients seeking assistance in emergency situations.

The California State Budget Act of 2000 provided the first cost of living increase to MSSP sites' budget, since the program was implemented in 1985. Stanislaus County's MSSP FY 2000-2001 budget will increase \$39,500, from \$698,708 to a total contract maximum of \$738,208.

The additional funds will be used to increase the contract with Health Services Agency for the provision of additional hours. This increase will reduce caseload ratios to 40 clients per case manager, improving services to elderly customers enrolled in MSSP. Additionally, the 20 potential clients on the current waiting list can be assessed for MSSP eligibility, allowing us to increase the average monthly case counts from 190 to 200.

The agency recommends accepting the contract amendment which will supplement the existing MSSP Contract effective July 1, 2000 through June 30, 2001.

POLICY ISSUE:

This program supports the Board of Supervisors priority of safe, healthy communities by providing additional services to frail elderly residents in order to maintain their independence and avoid institutionalized care.
