DISCUSSION:

In response to a complaint from the Board of Supervisors and the Department of Environmental Resources, the Public Works staff conducted a field investigation that revealed a vacant, fire damaged dwelling with major structural problems, a detached carport, and debris on the property, located at 5523 (5521) 9th Street, Keyes, California.

A letter was sent to the owner by certified mail with recommendation to demolish the structure and clean up the debris, but no action was taken. After several attempts were made to allow the owner (and heirs of the owner) to correct the problems, a Notice and Order was posted, the heirs of the owner were notified, and a Certificate of Existence was recorded by the Stanislaus County Clerk Recorder's Office. Demolition of the dwelling and detached carport was completed on January 17, 2001, with a total cost of \$6,186.00.

POLICY

ISSUE:

This action is consistent with the Board's policy of providing a safe, healthy community by removing dangerous structures and efficient government operations by recovering associated costs.
