## AUTHORIZATION TO ISSUE A REQUEST FOR PROPOSAL FOR THE OPERATION OF CONCESSIONS AT WOODWARD RESERVOIR AND MODESTO RESERVOIR REGIONAL PARKS PAGE 2

DISCUSSION:	The present lease agreements for the operation of the concessions at
	Woodward Reservoir and Modesto Reservoir will terminate as per
	contract, within the next month. These agreements have been in effect for
	the past eleven years. The department is requesting authorization to issue
	a Request For Proposal (RFP) to consider new proposals for the operation
	of these concessions.

The terms and conditions for the new lease agreements will be similar to the existing agreements, however, some changes will be necessary. The changes to the existing terms and conditions will address issues related to the following: the MTBE-FREE Zone at Modesto Reservoir, the domestic drinking water facility proposed at Woodward Reservoir, and the increased need for delivery of goods and services to the park customers. Staff is recommending the Board authorize the issuance of an RFP for the operation of the reservoir concessions; to include the selection, awarding, and signing of the concession contracts.

POLICY ISSUE:

The Board should decide if an RFP should be issued. This request is in line with the Board's priority of delivering excellent customer services.
