APPROVAL OF DEPARTMENT OF AGING & VETERANS SERVICES (AREA AGENCY ON AGING REQUEST FOR PROPOSAL PROCESS FOR FOSTER GRANDPARENT AND SENIOR COMPANION PROGRAMS, FISCAL YEAR 2001-2002

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DISCUS-SION: On January 19, 2001, the Area Agency on Aging received a letter from the Executive Director of Valley Mountain Regional Center, terminating the contract for Foster Grandparent and Senior Companion Programs in accordance with Article VI, Paragraph E, of the contract:

This Agreement may be canceled by either party upon thirty (30) days written notice for reasons including, but not limited to, events that occur beyond the control of the Contractor. In the event of cancellation notice, the AAA will present written notice to the Contractor of any conditions, such as care of clients, return of unspent funds, and disposition of property, which must be met prior to cancellation. Cancellation is effective only upon the written determination of the AAA that the Contractor has met those conditions."

With the termination of these contracts, funding for the Foster Grandparent and Senior Companion Programs will be available, as follows:

- \$40,254 for the Foster Grandparent Program, which pairs low-income seniors with exceptional needs children.
- \$58,648 for the Senior Companion Program, in which low-income seniors provide peer support to older, frail elderly persons in their community.

Service providers for these new contracts will be selected through a competitive procurement process. The California Department of Aging has issued instructions to area agencies on aging to conduct an open bid request for proposal (RFP) for these programs as specified in Chapter 7.5 of the Older Californians Act.

POLICY ISSUES:

Approval of these requests will meet the Board of Supervisors' goal of safe, healthy communities, and will allow the Area Agency on Aging to continue to provide these services.

STAFFING There will be no impact on staffing as a result of these IMPACT: actions.
