AUTHORIZATION FOR STANISLAUS COUNTY PARKS AND RECREATION DEPARTMENT TO APPLY FOR PROPOSITION 12 "LOCAL ASSISTANCE GRANT" FUNDING, FOR THE TURLOCK LAKE FISHING ACCESS. PAGE 2

**DISCUSSION:** 

The "Local Assistance Grant" is available through Proposition 12 funding for locally operated units of the California State park system. The Joint Operating Agreement (JOA), for, among other things, the operation of the Turlock Lake Fishing Access, into which the Stanislaus County Parks and Recreation Department and the California State Parks and Recreation Department would enter upon approval by the Board of Supervisors, qualifies Stanislaus County for this grant funding.

The grant amount of \$465,000 would be used to make improvements at the fishing access at the east end of Turlock Lake. These improvements would include gravel roads, pathways, a one lane boat ramp, and a restroom. The improvements are required as a condition of the State lease agreement with Turlock Irrigation District. The improvements must be completed by the year 2004 to keep this fishing access open to the public.

The JOA between the California State Department of Parks and Recreation and Stanislaus County Parks and Recreation Department would convey the responsibility of implementing the improvements to the County. This grant application would enable Stanislaus County to request funding through the Proposition 12 funds that are dedicated for the local agency operating units of the California State Parks. This grant would be for the cost of the improvements. The Stanislaus County Parks and Recreation Department would submit plans for the improvements to the State Department of Parks and Recreation and Turlock Irrigation District for their approval, once the grant is approved. Staff recommends the Board authorize the application for the grant.

POLICY ISSUE

Authorization from the Board is needed to submit the grant application. This request is in line with the Board's priority of promoting efficient government operations.
