## DISCUSSION:

The Chief Executive Office was fortunate to have several very highly qualified individuals to consider for the position of Chief Information Officer (CIO). Backgrounds are currently being conducted and it is anticipated that an offer above the mid-point of the band will be necessary in order to attract a candidate. For this reason, the Chief Executive Officer is asking for authority to appoint above the mid-point of the Band G, up to \$105,000 the first year. This is approximately \$9,000 above the mid-point of the range.

Additionally, this position will be comparable to department head level positions within the organization, including that of the Management Information Services Director. For this reason, it would be appropriate to extend a comparable level of benefits. For this reason, it is recommended that the Board extend department head benefits to the Chief Information Officer position. At the same time we are recommending department head benefits be extended to the Assistant Executive Officer in recognition of the significant countywide responsibilities that are assigned to this position.

## POLICY ISSUE:

Approval of this recommendation will meet the Board of Supervisors goal of providing excellent customer service

## STAFFING IMPACT:

Salary and Position Allocation Resolution will be amended to reflect the addition of department head benefits to the positions of Chief Information Officer and Assistant Executive Officer.
