DISCUSSION:

Under the zoning ordinance, a property owner may keep no more than two vehicles (cars, trucks, and trailers) that are disabled, under repair or restoration, or unregistered. Three or more such vehicles is declared a "Vehicle Storage Yard" under Stanislaus County Code section 21.12.625, and is prohibited. There is no limit on the number of vehicles that can be stored on property so long as they are road worthy and licensed.

The Stanislaus County Code Enforcement Taskforce identified a need to treat boats in the same manner as cars and trucks that are stored on private property. The proposed ordinance (Attachment 1) would add "vessels," as defined under the Harbors and Navigation Code, to the definition of a "Vehicle Storage Yard." Recognizing that a boat is typically stored and transported on a trailer (a vehicle itself), the proposed ordinance would treat a boat stored on a trailer as one unit for purposes of the section.

If the proposed ordinance amendment is adopted, a landowner could keep only two vehicles, or two boats, or one of each on private property if inoperable or unlicensed.

The Stanislaus County Planning Commission considered the proposed ordinance at its meeting on March 15, 2001, found that it is exempt from and not subject to the California Environmental Quality Act, and, after conducting a public hearing, recommended that the Board adopt the ordinance. Pursuant to Government Code section 65856, upon receipt of the recommendation of the Planning Commission, the Board should hold a public hearing to consider adopting the proposed ordinance.

Staff recommends that you (1) set April 24, 2001, at 9:25 a.m., or as soon thereafter as the matter may be heard, as the date to consider adoption of the proposed ordinance; and (2) authorize the Clerk of the Board to publish notice as required under subdivision (b) of section 65856 of the Government Code.

POLICY ISSUE:

This proposed ordinance supports the Board's Goals and Priorities of providing a safe, healthy community.

STAFFING IMPACT:

There are no staffing impacts associated with this action.

AN ORDINANCE ADDING VESSELS TO THE DEFINITION OF A VEHICLE STORAGE YARD

THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF THE COUNTY OF STANISLAUS, STATE OF CALIFORNIA, ORDAINS AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Section 21.12.625 of the Stanislaus County Code is amended to read as follows:

"'Vehicle storage yard' means any location consisting of parcel(s) or lot(s) where three or more vehicles (as defined by Section 670 CVC), or vessels (as defined by Section 651 of the Harbors and Navigation Code), or combinations of both, which are disabled, under repair or restoration, and/or vehicles or vessels which are not currently registered with the State Department of Motor Vehicles are stored. For purposes of this section, a vessel and a trailer designed to carry a vessel that are used together as one unit shall count as one vehicle or one vessel."

Section 2. This ordinance shall take effect thirty (30) days from and after the date of its passage and before the expiration of fifteen (15) days after its passage it shall be published once, with the names of the members voting for and against the same, in the Modesto Bee, a newspaper published in the County of Stanislaus, State of California.
