SUBJECT: APPROVAL TO CONSTRUCT A PIPELINE WITHIN COUNTY ROAD RIGHT-OF-WAY
ALONG VIVIAN ROAD IN THE VICINITY OF WEST MONTE VISTA AVENUE

DISCUSSION: Stanislaus County was contacted by Mr. Andy Zylstra about the possibility of constructing a pipeline along the right-of-way of Vivian Avenue from approximately 1,000 feet north of Monte Vista Avenue north one-half mile. Mr. Zylstra operates a dairy and this pipeline would allow him to dispose of dairy sludge on a parcel of land he purchased that is not contiguous to his dairy operation.

Mr. Zylstra does not have any other viable options that would allow him to construct this pipeline outside of County right-of-way. We, therefore, feel that his request is reasonable and are recommending its approval. Under Stanislaus County Code 13.04.020, the Board of Supervisors must approve any such pipeline installation. We are, therefore, requesting that this approval be granted subject to our standard encroachment permit requirements, including a maintenance agreement for the pipeline itself.

POLICY
