DISCUSSION:

The Families for Literacy program teaches parents how to read to their children and how to help their children develop healthy attitudes toward school, study and reading, in addition to their regular literacy studies. The program was initiated just this year as the result of a \$15,000 one year grant from the State Library. The State Library is now encouraging the Stanislaus County Library to apply for a second year of funding. Each year is independent, targets a different set of parents, and does not depend on the year before or after. This literacy program is designed to be completed within the year, making it unnecessary to provide additional library funds. The Families For Literacy grant includes administrative costs.
