DISCUSSION:The Scenic Faculty Medical Group (SFMG) is a strategic
partner in the County's provision of health care to its residents.
SFMG is the core faculty for the Family Practice Residency
Program that is affiliated with U.C. Davis. Approximately
40% of the primary care physicians in DMC's Family Practice
Department are graduates of the County's program. In
addition, the faculty group provides approximately 40% of
direct patient care for the Health Services Agency's clinics.
SFMG physicians provide services to other County
departments, including Behavioral Health and Recovery
Services and the Community Services Agency. The
presentation has been developed as a visual demonstration of
the role that SFMG plays in providing medical care.The diversity of physicians within SFMG is presented in a
format highlighting training and language skills to meet the
