

ORDINANCE NO. C.S. 764

**AN ORDINANCE RELATING TO ALCOHOL  
CONSUMPTION IN COMMUNITY PARKS**

THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF THE COUNTY OF STANISLAUS, STATE OF CALIFORNIA, ORDAINS AS FOLLOWS:

**Section 1.** Section 18.06.080 of the Stanislaus County Code is amended to read as follows:

"A. No person shall consume or have in his or her possession any can, bottle or other receptacle containing any alcoholic beverage which has been opened, or a seal broken, or the contents of which have been partially removed, in any and all community parks and neighborhood parks owned or operated by the County, except for special events at such parks that have been approved by the Board of Supervisors.

"B. This prohibition shall apply to all areas within community parks and neighborhood parks, including without limitation: park grounds, playgrounds, walkways, streets, driveways and parking lots, but excluding any community center buildings located within community parks and neighborhood parks.

"C. Nothing in this section should be construed to prohibit individuals from carrying closed alcoholic containers between the parking lot at any community parks and neighborhood parks and its associated community center building, if any, for the purposes of setting up or closing down a social event approved by the Board of Supervisors and for which use of the building has been reserved.

"D. Violation of this section shall be an infraction pursuant to Section 1.36.020 of this code."


**Section 2.** This ordinance shall take effect thirty (30) days from and after the date of its passage and before the expiration of fifteen (15) days after its passage it shall be published once, with the names of the members voting for and against the same, in the Modesto Bee, a newspaper published in the County of Stanislaus, State of California.

Upon motion of Supervisor Blom, seconded by Supervisor Mayfield, the foregoing resolution was passed and adopted at a regular meeting of the Board of Supervisors of the County of Stanislaus, State of California, the 19th day of June, 2001, by the following called vote:






