NAME: STANISLAUS COUNTY CHILDREN AND FAMILIES FIRST

COMMISSION (PROPOSITION 10)

Established: 8/8/2000

COMPENSATION: None, but may receive actual and necessary expenses as are incurred.

LEGAL AUTHORITY: Board of Supervisors Resolution # 98-950 (Urgency Ordinance C.S.687)

and #2000-637

MEMBERSHIP: The Commission shall consist of nine (9) members, **appointed** by the

Board of Supervisors.

QUALIFICATION: One member shall be from the Board of Supervisors.

AND RESIDENCY One member shall be the Community Services Agency Director.

REQUIREMENTS: One member shall be the County Health Officer.

One member shall be the Health Services Agency Director.

One member shall be the Director of Mental Health.

The remaining four members shall be recipients of program services; educators specializing in early childhood development, representatives of local child care resource or referral agency or local child care coordinating group, representatives of a local organization for prevention or early intervention for families at risk, representatives from community-based organizations that have a goal of promoting nurturing and early childhood development, representatives of local school districts, or representatives of local medical, pediatric or obstetric associations or societies.

TERM: Terms shall be for three years.

DUTIES:

To implement the goals and objectives of the Act. To administer the monies in the Stanislaus County Children and Families First Trust Fund. Adoption of a County Strategic Plan for the support and improvement of early childhood development within the County as outlined in the Act. To conduct at least one public hearing on its proposed Strategic Plan before the plan is adopted and before any revisions to the plan are adopted. To submit the adopted plan and any revisions to the State Commission and the Board of Supervisors. To prepare and adopt an annual audit and report pursuant to Health and Safety Code section 130150. To conduct at least one public hearing prior to adopting any annual audit and report. To conduct at least one public hearing on each annual report by the state commission prepared pursuant to Health and Safety Code section 130150, subdivision (b). To make copies of annual audits and reports available to members of the general public on request and at no cost. To exercise all powers, duties and functions as are prescribed by statute, the Board of Supervisors, and the Commission.
