DISCUSSION:

In response to a complaint from the Department of Environmental Resources, the Public Works staff conducted a field investigation that revealed one (1) vacant fire damaged structure (a dwelling), two metal storage sheds, and debris on the property, located at 1621 Portland Avenue, Modesto, California.

A letter was sent to the owner by certified mail with recommendation to demolish the structure and clean up the debris, but no action was taken. In fact, the letters were returned unopened and marked owner deceased. A "Notice and Order" was posted, the heirs of the owner were notified, and a Certificate of Existence was recorded by the Stanislaus County Clerk Recorder's Office. Approval for demolition was given by the Planning Commission on February 14, 2001, with Board of Supervisors approval on April 10, 2001. Demolition of the dwelling and storage buildings was completed on June 6, 2001, at a total cost of \$7,133.00.

This action is consistent with the Board's policy of providing a safe, healthy community by removing dangerous structures and efficient government operations by recovering associated costs.
