## DISCUSSION:

The Department of Parks and Recreation has received a request by the Salida Civic Association and the Salida Rotary Club to hold the Second annual Salida Town and Country Parade and Festival at Salida Park. The event would take place on Saturday, August 18, 2001.

This year's festival, which is open to the entire community, will start at 8:00A.M. and end at 4:00 P.M. The activities will consist of arts and crafts, food, live entertainment, kids activities, information booths and more.

Last year's event drew approximately 5,000 people and the hope is that this year the event will be even larger. The organizers have worked with the various permitting agencies for this event to ensure that all the needs of the event have been addressed, such as portable toilets, trash receptacles, parade permits, and an outdoor festival permit.

The Department of Parks and Recreation requests that the Board approve the staff recommendations.

## POLICY ISSUE:

The Board's authorization is needed for exclusive use of County facilities. This request meets the Board's priority of delivering excellent community service.
