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DISCUSSION: Given the financial challenges facing the Agency in the upcoming year, there is an intensified need for a strong Accounting Manager who can immediately work on improving accounting controls and performance. The Health Services Agency selected Mr. Wirtz to fill this position. Mr. Wirtz is currently working as a Accountant III with Behavioral Health and Recovery Services.

In the position of Accounting Manager, Mr. Wirtz will be overseeing the Finance Department at the Health Services Agency, supervising 16 employees. In this position he will be responsible for establishing the direction, organization and orchestrating the workflow of the Finance Office staff. He will be responsible to ensure quality service, and that the goals and objectives of the Health Services Agency's Finance Office are consistently met.

Mr. Wirtz has been with the County for almost three years. Behavioral Health and Recovery Services hired him in 1998 as an Accountant II. He was then promoted to Accountant III. He is very knowledgeable in Oracle and PeopleSoft and has previous experience with the Meditech Financial System, which is the primary system for HSA.

Prior to joining the Stanislaus County in 1998, Mr. Wirtz worked at both Memorial Hospital and Lodi Hospital. This has provided him with a strong background in healthcare accounting. In addition, he has been supervising staff in his role as accountant III at BHRS. Mr. Wirtz has significantly more relevant experience than the other candidates for the position.
