APPROVAL TO HOLD A SEVEN MILE FOOT RACE ON COUNTY ROADS SUBJECT: **ON SEPTEMBER 1, 2001** 2

DISCUSSION: Sierra Railroad Company has requested permission to hold a foot race near Oakdale on Saturday, September 1, 2001, on three County roads: Sierra Road, Wamble Road, and Fogarty Road. The foot race will be held from 6:00 a.m. until approximately 9:30 a.m. with no roads being closed. The foot race pits runners against a steam locomotive. There is one railroad crossing on the route that will be monitored by an official. Their job is to ensure that all runners will halt until the crossing is clear and the gates have risen.
