Dear Mr. Neubaum,

Your request for the use of the Woodward Reservoir for your home meet on Thursday, September 27th, 2001, was approved by the Board of Supervisors at their meeting of September 18, 2001.

The Board of Supervisors has waived all fees for the day, but you are required to have a \$1 million insurance policy which names Stanislaus County as co-insured on the policy. You <u>must</u> show a certificate of insurance to the Parks Department Office, 3800 Cornucopia Way, Suite C, Modesto, **no later than three days prior to your event**. If your organization does not have an existing insurance policy, you may wish to have another organization or group, which has insurance, sponsor the event. If your organization is affiliated with a national organization, it is likely that the national organization has insurance which may cover this event.

Also, all participants are required to sign the Stanislaus County Hold Harmless Agreement, which can be obtained from the Parks Department.

If you have any questions regarding insurance requirements, please contact Risk Management at 525-5712.

Your organization must remove all personal property immediately after the event and must leave the area in a clean and orderly manner. Any questions regarding user's responsibilities or release can be directed to Director of Parks, 525-6750.
