# AUTHORIZATION TO MODIFY HOURS AT THE KEYES LIBRARY Page 2

#### **DISCUSSION:**

The Keyes Library, located on the campus of the Keyes Elementary School, is open a total of 48 hours per week. Current hours are: Monday 9-5, Tuesday 9-5, Wednesday 9-5, Thursday 9-7, Friday 9-5, Saturday 12-6. Library staff has found very little usage by the community of the Keyes Library on Saturdays after 4 p.m. In a study done over a period of 16 Saturdays, it was shown only a total of 17 customers used the library from 4-6 p.m. The majority of Saturday customers used the library from 12-4 p.m. on those Saturdays.

Staff proposes shifting two hours from Saturday afternoons and adding them to weekday mornings. The total number of hours the library is open would not change. The Keyes Elementary School opens at 8:15 a.m. Adding more weekday morning hours would allow the library to serve more children, parents, and teachers. Staff has polled the teachers, the Keyes Elementary School District administration, the Keyes to Learning Charter School, and the Keyes Municipal Advisory Council on this matter. They have all agreed this would be a change for the better.

Proposed new hours: Monday 8:30-5, Tuesday 8:30-5, Wednesday 8:30-5, Thursday 8:30-7, Friday 9-5, Saturday 12-4.

### POLICY ISSUES:

The Board of Supervisors must decide whenever hours of service are changed for a county facility. This issue addresses the Board goals of efficient government operations and a safe and healthy community.

## STAFFING IMPACT:

There is no staffing impact associated with this change in hours.
