AUTHORIZE THE AUDITOR-CONTROLLER TO INCREASE BUDGET EXPENDITURES AND REVENUES PER THE ATTACHED BUDGET JOURNAL FORM FOR FISCAL YEAR 2001/2002 FOR THE PROVISION OF YOUTH SERVICES USING CALWORKS INCENTIVE FUNDS. Page 2

FISCAL IMPACT:

This agenda item requests authorization to increase budget appropriations and revenues for fiscal year 2001/2002 per the attached budget journal to partially fund a Day Reporting Center program for highrisk juvenile court wards residing in the community and to fund a STD/HIV and Teen Pregnancy Prevention Program for Juvenile Hall detainees. Appropriations and corresponding revenues for the succeeding years will be included in the appropriate fiscal year Probation Department budget request.

DISCUSSION:

On May 15, 2001, the Board of Supervisors authorized the Community Services Agency to enter into a three-year agreement with the Probation Department for the provision of youth services using CalWORKS Incentive funds not to exceed \$400,000 for the three-year period.

The funding provided by the May 15, 2001 Board action will partially fund a Day Reporting Center program for high-risk juvenile court wards residing in the community. An STD/HIV and Teen Pregnancy Prevention Program for Juvenile Hall detainees will also be funded with this money. The Day Reporting Center program and the STD/HIV and Teen Pregnancy Prevention program for minors in Juvenile Hall meets the Temporary Assistance to Needy Families (TANF) Goal Number 3: Prevention and reduction of the incidence of out-of-wedlock pregnancies.


POLICY ISSUE:

Changes in appropriations require Board of Supervisors approval. This program supports the Board's priorities for safe and healthy communities, excellent community services, and multi-jurisdictional cooperation.
