APPROVAL TO ACCEPT SUPPLEMENTAL GRANT FUNDS FROM THE OFFICE OF NATIONAL DRUG CONTROL POLICY (ONDCP) FOR THE CENTRAL VALLEY CALIFORNIA HIGH INTENSITY DRUG TRAFFICKING AREA (HIDTA) FOR THE CALENDAR YEAR 2001; AMEND THE SALARY AND POSITION ALLOCATION RESOLUTION; PURCHASE EQUIPMENT – SHERIFF PAGE 2

DISCUSSION: In the continuing fight against Methamphetamine, the HIDTA Executive Committee has reviewed and approved the following new initiatives/program.

Fresno Area Surveillance Team (FAST):

Their mission is to disrupt and dismantle the flow of precursor and essential chemicals supplied by domestic and foreign drug trafficking groups, organizations and individuals trafficking in chemicals used to manufacture Methamphetamine (meth). The team will be targeting the telephones of chemical brokers supplying clandestine meth laboratories. They will additionally investigate money-laundering operations assisting these chemical brokers with movement and/or concealment of their illegal profits. FAST will work with HIDTA and other law enforcement units, such as the US Attorney's Office, local District Attorney's Offices, major narcotic units, DEA's Diversion Unit in conjunction with California Department of Justice – Bureau of Narcotic Enforcement Chemical Unit.

Precursor/Vendor Program:

The purpose is to educate and network with retailers of precursor chemicals, which is one of the stated goals of HIDTA. This new program will provide funding for one Deputy Sheriff for the Sacramento Area Intelligence/Narcotic Task Force (SAINT) and one Deputy Sheriff-Coroner for the Stanislaus, San Joaquin, Merced Task Force (SSJM) located in Modesto. Both officers would be assigned to HIDTA full time. The Deputy Sheriff-Coroner for SSJM would be a newly allocated position for Stanislaus County.

Financial Investigative Task Force:

The mission is to enhance HIDTA's goal of identifying and targeting money laundering operations undertaken by drug trafficking organizations. The money laundering initiative will be collocated with the SAINT in Sacramento. A senior Internal Revenue Service Special Agent working with the SAINT initiative commander will oversee the program.

Additionally, the Executive Committee has approved the purchase of equipment. Items purchased under the HIDTA grant are considered federal property. The grant has strict guidelines for the disposal of items at the end of the grant funding.

POLICY Approval of these supplemental grant funds will support this Board's policies for a safe and healthy community and multi-jurisdictional cooperation.

ISSUES: Amender STAFFING position IMPACT: Sherif

Amend the Salary and Position allocation resolution to add one Deputy Sheriff-Coroner position to Sheriff legal budget unit 28200. This allocation will cover costs of one Deputy Sheriff-Coroner position up to a maximum amount of \$69,519 per year. Remaining costs for this position are funded in the governor's Methamphetamine Initiative funds (CAL-MMET). There is no general fund matching requirement.
