APPROVE ACCEPTANCE OF FISCAL YEAR 2001-2002 GRANT FROM THE OFFICE OF CRIMINAL JUSTICE PLANNING FOR DISTRICT ATTORNEY'S OFFICE STATUTORY RAPE VERTICAL PROSECUTION PROGRAM GRANT, page 2

DISCUSSION:

The Office of Criminal Justice Planning has funded the Statutory Rape Vertical Prosecution Program grant for several years. This grant provides for the vigorous vertical prosecution of perpetrators of statutory rape and also provides for extensive outreach to the community on this subject. Reapplication for FY 2001-2002 has been made to the Office of Criminal Justice Planning for continued funding for this grant, and the application has been accepted and the award granted.

The Statutory Rape Vertical Prosecution Program grant funds a dedicated Deputy District Attorney and Interviewer, and partially funds a Criminal Investigator for this project, as well as a small amount for training and operating costs. A Paralegal position at 50% time is currently unfilled as it was determined that funding could be better utilized filling other needs. There is no cash match required in this project, but the District Attorney's office provides additional investigative services beyond those funded by the grant. Projected revenues and expenditures for this grant were reflected in the District Attorney's budget for FY 2001-2002.

POLICY ISSUES:

Acceptance of this grant will help the District Attorney's office continue to meet the Board's goal of a safe healthy community by continuing the aggressive prosecution of perpetrators of statutory rape, and prevention via an effective community outreach and education program.

STAFFING IMPACTS:

None at this time.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the resolution shall be in effect for a three (3) year period beginning July 1, 2001 and ending June 30, 2004.
