APPROVE ACCEPTANCE OF FISCAL YEAR 2001-2002 GRANT FROM THE OFFICE OF CRIMINAL JUSTICE PLANNING FOR DISTRICT ATTORNEY'S OFFICE CAREER CRIMINAL PROSECUTION PROGRAM GRANT, page 2

DISCUSSION:

The Office of Criminal Justice Planning has funded the Career Criminal Prosecution Program grant for several years. This grant provides for the vigorous vertical prosecution of "career criminals", individuals who have established a pattern of serious or violent criminal activity threatening the safety of the community. Reapplication for FY 2001-2002 has been made to the Office of Criminal Justice Planning for continued funding for this grant, and the application has been accepted and the award granted.

The Career Criminal Prosecution Program grant originally fully funded the cost of a dedicated Deputy District Attorney and Criminal Investigator. Unfortunately, many OCJP grants do not include funding for COLAs, promotions or other salary and benefits increases, so over the past few years the grant funding (which has remained stable for several years) has become insufficient to fully cover these salaries. While there is no required county match in this program, the Board has generously provided additional funding to fully fund these positions. Projected revenues and expenditures for this grant were reflected in the District Attorney's budget for FY 2001-2002.

POLICY ISSUES:

Acceptance of this grant will help the District Attorney's office continue to meet the Board's goal of a safe healthy community by continuing the aggressive prosecution of professional criminals, directing the efforts of its prosecutor and investigator towards the goal of keeping these habitual, career offenders in custody for the longest period mandated by law.

None at this time.

IT IS AGREED that any liability arising out of the performance of these Grant Award Agreements, including civil court actions for damages, shall be the responsibility of the grant recipient and the authorizing agency. The State of California and the OCJP disclaim responsibility for any such liability.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that grant funds received hereunder shall not be used to supplant expenditures controlled by this body.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the resolution shall be in effect for a three (3) year period beginning **July 1, 2001 and ending June 30, 2004**.
