CONSIDERATION OF APPROVAL OF RESIDENTIAL AND COMMERCIAL REFUSE COLLECTION RATE ADJUSTMENTS Page 2

DISCUSSION:

On November 6, 2001, the Board considered and approved the staff recommendation to decrease disposal fees at the Waste-to-Energy facility and the Fink Road Landfill from \$34.00 per ton to \$30.00 per ton effective January 1, 2002. The Modesto City Council is scheduled to consider the decrease in disposal fees at the Waste-to-Energy facility on November 13. Pending approval by the Modesto City Council, this decrease in disposal fees allows a corresponding decrease in most of the refuse collection rates charged to the residents and businesses in the unincorporated areas of the county. The recommended rate adjustments are shown in Attachment "A". If approved, the changes would become effective January 1, 2002.

The charge for drop box service is composed of a haul charge, the disposal fee, the franchise fee and, depending on the destination of the drop box, a transfer fee. Since the disposal fee is decreasing, we would expect that most users will also see a decrease in their charges.

Franchise refuse service rate adjustments would affect only the customers in the unincorporated areas of the county. It should be noted that County Counsel has opined that a Public Hearing is not required for the Board to decrease fees. Consistent with past practice, the Department notified the owners of 66 mobile home parks located in the unincorporated county areas that residential and commercial refuse collection rates were being considered for an adjustment.

POLICY ISSUE:

Adjusting refuse service rates downward is consistent with the Board's priorities of delivering excellent community service and facilitating economic development.
