APPROVAL TO INTRODUCE AND WAIVE THE FIRST READING OF AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND TITLE 11 OF THE STANISLAUS COUNTY CODE, ADDING A NO TRUCK PARKING ZONE ON CLAUS ROAD AND SISK ROAD; A WHITE ZONE - ESTABLISHED ON HERNDON AVENUE; AND, HIGHWAYS PROHIBITED WITHIN RESIDENTIAL AREAS ON CHICAGO AVENUE.

DISCUSSION:

"No Truck Parking" zones on Claus Road and Sisk Road were requested by adjacent residents. There are many trucks parking on these streets and the available sight visibility of the nearby intersecting streets and driveways is reduced.

A "White Zone - Established" on Herndon Avenue was requested by the Tuolumne School and is necessary to control the areas where students can be dropped off. A "White Zone - Established" is where the curb is painted white to indicate the location where passengers can be loaded or unloaded. The time allowed for the loading or unloading will be noted on the signs or the curb that designates the white zone.

A "Highways Prohibited - Within Residential Area" is an ordinance to prohibit trucks from residential areas. Residents on Chicago Avenue requested a study to determine if trucks can be restricted from traveling on this street. The study showed the road to be narrow, residential, and that nearby adjacent truck routes were available. Trucks that have a destination on Chicago Avenue can still legally use the road.

The proposed ordinance has the recommendation of this Department and approval as to form from County Counsel. Therefore, it is recommended that you introduce the ordinance and waive the reading thereof.

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING NO TRUCK PARKING ZONES, WHITE ZONES - ESTABLISHED, AND HIGHWAYS PROHIBITED WITHIN RESIDENTIAL AREAS

THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF THE COUNTY OF STANISLAUS ORDAINS AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Section 11.08.120 (No Truck Parking) of the Stanislaus County Code is hereby amended to add subsection 9 (Claus Road) and subsection 10 (Sisk Road) to read as follows:

- "9. Claus Road. On the east side of Claus Road from a point 660 feet south of its intersection thereof with Townsend Avenue, north to its intersection with California Avenue.
- "10. Sisk Road. On the west side of Sisk Road from its intersection thereof with Pelandale Avenue, north to a point 540 feet north of said intersection."
- Section 2. Section 11.12.040. (White Zones Established) of the Stanislaus County Code is hereby amended by adding subsection I (Herndon Avenue) to read as follows:
- "I. Herndon Avenue. On the west side of Herndon Avenue from a point 245 feet south of its intersection with Sonora Avenue, southerly 145 feet to a point 390 feet south of said intersection; and, on the west side of Herndon Avenue from a point 415 feet south of its intersection with Sonora Avenue, southerly 25 feet to a point 440 feet south of said intersection."
- Section 3. Section 11.16.030. (Highways Prohibited Within Residential Area) of the Stanislaus County Code is hereby amended by adding subsection 137 (Chicago Avenue) to read as follows:
- "137. Chicago Avenue. On Chicago Avenue from its intersection with Paradise Road to its intersection with Carpenter Road."
- Section 4. This ordinance shall take effect 30 days from and after the date of its passage, and before the expiration of 15 days after its passage, it shall be published once with the names of the members voting for and against the same in the Modesto Bee, a newspaper in the County of Stanislaus, State of California.
