The purpose of this project is to provide a secure employee parking area through the installation of fencing around the employee parking area of the Paradise Medical Office. The scope of this project includes the installation of 370 lineal feet of 6 feet high commercial ornamental iron fencing with two single swing gates with control locks and three 20 feet wide single slide gates (two electronic operations and one manual operation). 
