STAFF RECOMMENDATIONS (Continued):

4. Direct the Auditor-Controller to increase appropriations and estimated revenue to the Mental Health Services Act budget unit (1507) in the amount of \$294,300, as detailed in the Budget Journal form.

DISCUSSION:

On August 10, 2007, the State Department of Mental Health issued preliminary instructions to counties to begin preparation of the plan for the Prevention and Early Intervention component of the Mental Health Services Act. Upon successful completion of the plan, Stanislaus County may receive up to \$3,792,500 to implement Mental Health Prevention and Early Intervention services through June 30, 2009.

The State has also identified funding available for a broad-based Community Planning process and asked counties to submit a Request for Funding application for approval. On October 22, 2007, Stanislaus County received notification that its request for \$294,300 in Community Program Planning funds has been approved. The funding will be used to support the community stakeholder input process and identify community mental health needs. To support this process, the Department plans to contract with a local grant writer who has broad knowledge of the community and a background in Asset Based Community Development concepts. The balance of the funding will be used to fund a portion of the Behavioral Health and Recovery Services Training Coordinator's time and for ancillary items required to hold the stakeholder meetings, such as equipment, facility costs, refreshments, and printing.

The Department is requesting authorization to accept these funds and begin the planning activities with an anticipated submission timeframe during Spring 2008.

POLICY ISSUE:

Acceptance of these funds supports the Board of Supervisors' priorities of a safe community, a healthy community and the efficient delivery of public services.

STAFFING IMPACT:

There is no staffing impact associated with this item.
