**SUBJECT: REQUEST FROM ROTARY CLUB OF MODESTO NORTH FOR THE USE
OF FRANK RAINES REGIONAL PARK AND UNITED COMMUNITY PARK**

The Department has received a request from the Rotary Club of Modesto North (GROUP), to utilize Frank Raines Park, Day Use Area and Grayson United Community Park as rest stops for their Annual Canyon Classic Century to be held on Saturday, June 14, 2008 between the hours of 5:30 a.m. and 4:30 p.m.

The Department does not have any objections to this request and recommends the Board to approve the request as follows:

- By Thursday, June 5, 2008, no later than 1:00 p.m., require the GROUP to provide the Department of Parks and Recreation, Attention Margarita D. Ramos, Deputy Director, its Certificate of Insurance with a minimum general liability of \$1 million and the Endorsement naming Stanislaus County as an additional insured.
- By Thursday, June 5, 2008, no later than 1:00 p.m., require the Hold Harmless Agreement (Group) to be completed and returned to the Department of Parks and Recreation, Attn: Margarita D. Ramos, Deputy Director.
- The expected number of participants for this event is 400.
- Exclusive Use Fee to be waived.
- Administrative/Reservation Fee to be waived.
- The area is to be left in a clean condition.
- Portable restrooms must be provided for your participants at Frank Raines Regional Park, Day Use Area.
- Portable restrooms should be provided for your participants at Grayson United Community Park as the Center restrooms are not under the jurisdiction of the Department of Parks and Recreation
