DISCUSSION:

The Edward Byrne Memorial Justice Assistance Grant (JAG) Program allows states, tribes, and local governments to support a broad range of activities to prevent and control crime based on their own local needs and conditions. JAG blends in the Local Law Enforcement Block Grant Program to provide agencies with the flexibility to prioritize and place justice funds where they are needed most. Funds through the Local Law Enforcement Block Grant are no longer available.

Funding in the amount of \$31,825 is available in 2008 from the JAG program for use in Stanislaus County. A County match is not required. Awards are made in the first fiscal year of the appropriation and may be expended during the following three years for a total of four years. This is the fourth year that the JAG program will be available. Funding received from the 2005, 2006, and 2007 JAG have been utilized to fund positions that were previously funded through the Local Law Enforcement Block Grant.

Currently positions originally funded through grand funds are:

- ◆ Probation Department for one full time Deputy Probation Officer for the Domestic Violence Program at an approximate yearly cost of \$93,661, and
- ♦ Sheriff's Department for one full time Deputy Sheriff to provide community policing services for the South Modesto area surrounding the Shackelford School area and funding for half of a Deputy Sheriff position to provide a School Resource Officer on site at the Tuolumne Elementary School at an approximate yearly cost of \$173,006.

A decrease in available funding for the 2008 JAG program has resulted in a decrease in funding of approximately \$68,040 under the 2007 JAG. The 2008 JAG funds of \$31,825 will make it possible to fund one Deputy Probation Officer position for approximately 1.4 months and will fund both the community policing and school resource officer for approximately 1.4 months of the 2008-2009 Fiscal Year. Both the Probation and the Sheriff's Department have sufficient funds to maintain these positions through the Final Budget process. The Department's will review these positions along with other unmet needs in the Final Budget process in order to analyze the impact of positions effected by funding shortfalls and to prioritize funding based on the most critical Department needs.

Recommend distribution of the 2008 JAG funds as follows:

Probation \$ 11,180 Sheriff \$ 20,645 Total \$ 31,825

If the Board of Supervisors concur, an application will be finalized with the Bureau of Justice Assistance for this funding. Unfortunately the Deputy Probation Officer and Deputy Sheriff' positions will not be fully funded in the 2008-2009 Fiscal Year by this

grant; however, both departments can fully fund these positions until the Final Budget at which time funding for these positions will be reviewed.

POLICY ISSUE:

Board approval to apply for this entitlement funding is necessary prior to the obligation of program funds. Utilization of this funding will enhance criminal justice processes in our community; consistent with the Board's stated priorities of ensuring a safe, healthy community and effective partnerships.

STAFFING IMPACT:

There are no recommendations to modify the Salary and Position Allocation Resolution by this action.
