Approval to Extend the Child Abuse Prevention Intervention and Treatment, Community-Based Child Abuse Prevention and Promoting Safe and Stable Families Three-Year Plan and Integrate into the California Children and Family Services Review Process - Community Services Agency

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STAFF RECOMMENDATIONS (CONTINUTED):

4. Sign the Notice of Intent Regarding Child Abuse Prevention Intervention and Treatment, Community Based Child Abuse Prevention, and Promoting Safe and Stable Families Contracts for Stanislaus County.

DISCUSSION:

On August 23, 2005, the Board of Supervisors approved the Community Services Agency (CSA) Promoting Safe and Stable Families (PSSF), Child Abuse Prevention, Intervention and Treatment (CAPIT), and Community Based Child Abuse Prevention (CBCAP) Three-Year Plan. The submission of a three-year plan to the California Department of Social Services, Office of Child Abuse Prevention has been a requirement for continued State funding for the Child Abuse Prevention, Intervention and Treatment Program (CAPIT), the Community Based Child Abuse Prevention (CBCAP) and the Promoting Safe and Stable Families (PSSF) programs.

Historically, CSA has submitted a CAPIT/CBCAP/PSSF Three-Year Plan (2002, 2005) to the California Department of Social Services, Office of Child Abuse Prevention to receive funding. Additionally, every three years, CSA has submitted the System Improvement Plan (2004, 2007) to the California Department of Social Services. The System Improvement Plan is developed upon our County's Self Assessment process and identifies strategies by which the Child and Family Services Division plans to improve targeted outcomes and/or systemic factors.

In an effort to minimize duplicative processes, maximize resources, and increase partnerships and communication between organizations, the California Department of Social Services, in collaboration with the County Welfare Directors Association (CWDA) of California is integrating the CAPIT/CBCAP/PSSF three year plan into the California Children and Family Services Review (C-CFSR). In this integration, the needs assessment for the CAPIT/CBCAP/PSSF Plan will be integrated into the County's Self Assessment process and the planning component will be become part of the System Improvement Plan process.

By way of integrating these plans which are on different tri-annual cycles, and due to the expiration of the CAPIT/CBCAP/PSSF Plans on June 30, 2008, the need for a transition strategy was recognized. The County's next System Improvement Plan is due to the state in 2010. To seamlessly integrating the CAPIT/CBCAP/PSSF three-year plan with CSA's System Improvement Plan, the State provided three options:

Approval to Extend the Child Abuse Prevention Intervention and Treatment, Community-Based Child Abuse Prevention and Promoting Safe and Stable Families Three-Year Plan and Integrate into the California Children and Family Services Review Process - Community Services Agency

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- Extend the timeframe of the existing approved CAPIT/CBCAP/PSSF Plan and, as appropriate, vendor contracts, through Fiscal Year 2008-2009 and until the next CSA System Improvement Plan cycle Fiscal Year 2009-2010;
- Submit an update to the County's existing CAPIT/CBCAP/PSSF Plan until the next CSA System Improvement Plan cycle; or
- Submit a new CAPIT/CBCAP/PSSF Plan for an interim period that includes all the elements as outlined in the 2005-2008 Three-Year Plan.

CSA has selected the first option contingent on Board of Supervisors approval.

The Office of Child Abuse Prevention must be notified by July 14, 2008, of the County's intent to use the above option by completing and submitting a Notice of Intent Regarding CAPIT/CBCAP/PSSF plan.

As part of the integration process, initially, a Notice of Intent Regarding CAPIT/CBCAP/PSSF Plan Contracts will also be submitted. Thereafter, this Notice of Intent will be due with the County's System Improvement Plan.

POLICY ISSUE:

Approving the recommended extension and signing the Notice of Intent supports the Board's priority for *A healthy community* through continued support of community-based organizations providing child abuse prevention services.
