DISCUSSION:

The California Integrated Waste Management Board (CIWMB) is currently offering 17th Cycle funding opportunities for Fiscal Year (FY) 2008–2009 Household Hazardous Waste (HHW) Grants to counties for the expansion of HHW management programs. Assembly Bill 1220 established this grant program in 1993 to assist local governments by offering monies for programs to divert hazardous waste from landfills. These are competitive grants and it is anticipated that \$5 million will be available in this year's grant cycle. The CIWMB has determined that a maximum of \$40,000 will be allotted for programs specifically related to home-generated sharps disposal and container exchange. In addition to this amount, the Department of Environmental Resources (Department) proposes to apply for an additional \$40,000 for publicity to promote the program for a total request of \$80,000 in grant funds. The term of the grant funds extend until April 30, 2011.

In the application, the Department will propose to purchase certified sharps containers which would be provided to residents in exchange for bringing a full sharps container to the HHW Facility located at 1716 Morgan Road, Modesto. Home-generated sharps waste means hypodermic needles, pen needles, intravenous needles, lancets, and other devices that are used to penetrate the skin for the delivery of medications derived from a household, including a multifamily residence or household. Additional monies obtained through the grant would be used for publicity and educational activities designed to educate the community regarding the disposal of home-generated sharps as well as HHW, electronic, and universal waste.

The State of California recently enacted Senate Bill 1305, which prohibits the disposal of homegenerated sharps in trash, recycling, and green waste containers effective September 1, 2008. According to the Center for Disease Control, there are 11.1 million diabetes sufferers in the United States and roughly another 6 million cases are undiagnosed. It is estimated that there are over 18,000 diabetics within Stanislaus County that could produce home-generated sharps. Currently, the HHW Facility is the only location in Stanislaus County that is listed by the California Department of Public Health as a consolidation point where the public can dispose of sharps.

The CIWMB has indicated that priority funding is given to multi-jurisdictional HHW programs (i.e., two or more cities/counties) and applicants that have not been awarded funds within the previous two grant cycles. Both of these criteria apply to the Department's application for this Cycle.

Stanislaus County has operated a HHW collection program since 1992, as well as a Universal Waste collection program since 2005. The County maintains a permanent HHW collection facility at 1716 Morgan Road, Modesto, for residential and small business customers, and provides mobile collection services to many of the cities within the County. Services are funded by a surcharge on refuse deposited at the Waste-To-Energy facility, however, costs are expected to increase when the sharps ban becomes effective on September 1, 2008. Given this, these grant

funds would go a long way to offset the Department's increased costs for this additional waste stream.

The grant application deadline is September 8, 2008. If the HHW application is selected for funding, the Department will return to the Board with the completed proposal and request board approval to accept and administer the grant. As a part of the grant application process, the Department must submit a Board of Supervisors' Resolution (Attachment "A").

POLICY ISSUE:

The Board of Supervisors should determine if applying for a Household Hazardous Waste Grant from the California Integrated Waste Management Board for Sharps Container Exchange and Disposal is consistent with the Board's priorities of a safe community, a healthy community, and the efficient delivery of public services
