DISCUSSION:

The attached list of Independent Contractors includes physicians who fulfill the mission of the Health Services Agency in providing medical care and teaching services for the Family Medicine Residency program. These services and corresponding anticipated expenses were previously approved by the Board on June 24, 2008 under the physicians' group name (Modesto Arts Medical Group). The outcome of negotiations with the group requires that the contracts be entered with the individual physicians. In the spirit of transparency, the Agency is requesting permission to enter these contracts although the intended expenditure has already been approved.

The total amount of contracts over \$100,000 cumulatively, to be approved by the Board through this agenda item is \$112,500 for Fiscal Year 2008-2009.
