Acceptance of Mental Health Services Act Community Services and Supports Funding Augmentation for Community-based Mental Health Services, Approval to Amend the Agreement with the State Department of Mental Health and Increase the Budget - Behavioral Health and Recovery Services Page 2

DISCUSSION:

In January 2006, Behavioral Health and Recovery Services began receiving an annual allocation from the Mental Health Services Act (MHSA) to pay for transformative services to children and adolescents under age 18 who are severely emotionally disturbed, and adults and seniors with serious mental illnesses. This revenue is the result of a 1% tax on incomes over \$1,000,000. The revenue received annually is based on projected tax receipts. If those estimates are lower than actual receipts, the Department of Mental Health allocates the difference to Counties. On October 29, 2008, Behavioral Health and Recovery Services was notified that \$1,189,700 would be available upon submission of an approved plan. Stanislaus County's plan was approved on October 29, 2008.
