DISCUSSION:

Center for Human Services, is a non-profit, community-based organization whose mission is to support the well being of youth and families through quality prevention, education and counseling services; through programs that build and strengthen families and the neighborhoods in which they live; and in a way that honors and respects the diversity of our community. The Center for Human Services has requested the donation of a variety of surplus office equipment, (list attached.) The General Services Agency warehouse has the requested surplus items that would fit the needs of the organization. Transfer of the surplus items to Center for Human Services will reduce the amount of surplus goods at the warehouse and assist Center for Human Services in meeting their mission to provide youth counseling and education.
