Section 1. Subsection E of §10.13.010 of the Stanislaus County Code is amended to read as follows:

"E. Number of Tables. The total number of gaming tables allowed in a gambling establishment shall not exceed eight gaming tables. The number of gaming tables shall be set forth in the license required by Chapter 10.12 of this code and must be authorized and approved by the state of California and comply with any and all applicable state and local laws, ordinances and regulations."

Section 2. This ordinance shall take effect thirty (30) days from and after the date of its passage and before the expiration of fifteen (15) days after its passage it shall be published once, with the names of the members voting for and against the same, in the <u>Modesto Bee</u>, a newspaper published in the County of Stanislaus, State of California.
