The ISRF Program offers low-cost loan financing to cities, counties, redevelopment agencies and special districts for up to sixteen different categories of public infrastructure which include, but are not limited to, roads, water treatment and distribution, water supply, flood control, public transit, sewage collection and treatment and public safety facilities.

We have financed a variety of projects throughout the State, including:

- \$7,200,000 to County of Kern for the Kern County Supervisorial District 5 Curb, Gutter, and Drainage Improvements Project.
- \$2,000,000 to the Eureka Redevelopment Agency for the C Street and Market Square Improvements Project.
- \$5,356,000 to the City of Porterville for the Wastewater Treatment Facility Upgrade and Sludge Disposal Project.
- \$4,000,000 City of Sacramento for the Basin 31 Detention Basin at 65th Street and Broadway Project.
