Approval to Summarily Vacate the Portion of an 18-Foot Alley Located Adjacent to Lots 12-16 of Block 5 South of Modesto Irrigation District High Line Lateral and North of 2nd Street in the Community of Empire in Stanislaus County

DISCUSSION:

This item is regarding the portion of 18' alley of Block 5 located south of Modesto Irrigation District High Line Lateral and north of 2nd Street in the community of Empire. Stanislaus County has not improved or maintained this section of road and has no need for this easement. The utility companies, AT&T, Pacific Gas & Electric, City of Modesto (Water) and Modesto Irrigation District have no facilities now or in the foreseeable future within the abandonment area and have no objections to the abandonment. The area is not being used for public use or access. Pursuant to Street and Highway Code 8333(c), which states that the legislative body may summarily vacate if the easement has been determined to be excess, and there are no other public facilities located within the easement. This summary abandonment will allow improvements to be completed by the adjacent landowner, Ms. Carolyn Morgan who requested this abandonment.

Department staff attended the March 9, 2009 meeting of the Empire Municipal Advisory Council (MAC) to discuss the recommended abandonment. Neither the Empire MAC nor the residents in attendance expressed concerns with staff's recommendation.

POLICY ISSUES:

The Board of Supervisors should consider if the recommended action is consistent with its priority of a well-planned infrastructure system.

There is no staffing impact associated with this item.


All that portion of the southerly section of Block 5 Alley of said map, as dedicated for road purposes, bounded by the following described lines:
