Approval to Summarily Vacate the Western Portion of the 20' Alley Located Adjacent to Lots 9-12 of Block 4903 East of Carpenter Road in Stanislaus County

3. Adopt the attached Resolution vacating the western section of the alley located adjacent to Block 4903 running in an east-west direction.

DISCUSSION:

The requested item is the abandonment of the westerly 110 feet of the 20' alley of Block 4903 located south of Paradise Road between Carpenter Road and Manor Drive in Stanislaus County. Stanislaus County has not improved or maintained this section of road and has no need for this easement. The area is not being used for public use or access.

The utility company AT&T has no facilities now or in the foreseeable future within the abandonment area and has no objections to the abandonment. The utility companies Pacific Gas & Electric, City of Modesto (Water) and Modesto Irrigation District have facilities within the abandoned area and request an easement be established to protect in-place facilities.

This summary abandonment will allow landscape improvements to be completed to the parcels on both sides of the alley by the landowner, Mr. Dennis Lewis, who requested this abandonment.

POLICY ISSUES:

Street and Highway Code 8334(a) states that the legislative body my summarily vacate if the easement has been determined to be excess, and not required for street and highway purposes. The Board of Supervisors should consider if the recommended action is consistent with its priority of a well-planned infrastructure system.

There is no staffing impact associated with this item.


The westerly 110 foot portion of the northerly 20-alley of Block 4903 of said map, as dedicated for road purposes, bounded by the following described lines:
