Approval to Summarily Vacate the 15-Foot Oakdale Irrigation District Irrigation Easement Located on the Southerly Side of Lots 9-17 Hillsborough Estates Subdivision No. 2

DISCUSSION:

This item is regarding the proposed 15-foot O.I.D. Irrigation Easement, located on the southerly side of Lots 9-17 Hillsborough Estates Subdivision No. 2 in Volume 43 of Maps, page 63, filed on June 8, 2007, in Stanislaus County, also being located east of the City of Oakdale, adjacent to the intersection of Foxborough Drive and Goldsborough Drive. This easement has never been accepted by the Oakdale Irrigation District. The utility companies, AT&T, PG&E and Oakdale Irrigation District have no facilities now or in the foreseeable future within the abandonment area and have no objections to the abandonment. Pursuant to Street and Highway Code 8333(c), which states that the legislative body may summarily vacate if the easement has been determined to be excess, and no other public facilities are located within the easement. This summary abandonment is being requested by the current landowner, Stanislaus Development, LLC.

The irrigation easement was originally offered on Book 32 of Parcel Maps, page 88, Stanislaus County records for public use. This vacation will eliminate any interest Stanislaus County has or may have in the easement.

POLICY ISSUES:

Street and Highway Code 8333(c) state that the legislative body may summarily vacate if the easement has been determined to be excess, and not required for street and highway purposes. The Board of Supervisors should consider if the recommended action is consistent with its priority of a well-planned infrastructure system.

STAFFING IMPACT:

There is no staffing impact associated with this item.


