#### DISCUSSION:

In Fiscal Year 2006-2007, the State appropriated funding statewide to expand and enhance current Substance Abuse and Crime Prevention Act programming, more commonly known as Proposition 36. The funding is provided through the Substance Abuse Offender Treatment Program. The goal of the funding is to improve Proposition 36 offender accountability; increase participation, retention and completion rates; and expand treatment services.

Funding for this program has continued over the last two fiscal years, unfortunately at reduced amounts. On an annual basis, counties are asked to submit a plan for continued funding at the amounts established through the State Budget. Stanislaus County was allocated \$248,719 for Fiscal Year 2008-2009. Recently the State allocated additional funding to 12 counties; Stanislaus was awarded \$5,600. This award consists of \$5,040 in State General Funds and \$560 in local match, which is a commitment of local funds at a ratio of one dollar for every nine State dollars. This match is required to draw down the State General Funds, and will be provided through existing funds in the Stanislaus Recovery Center budget unit.

The criteria for continued funding through this program include the following:

- The establishment and maintenance of a dedicated Court calendar with regularly scheduled reviews of treatment progress for persons ordered to drug treatment;
- The establishment of a Drug Court, and a willingness to accept defendants who are likely to be committed to state prison;
- The establishment and maintenance of protocols for the use of drug testing to monitor offenders' progress in treatment; and
- The establishment and maintenance of protocols for assessing offenders' treatment needs and the placement of offenders at the appropriate level of treatment.

The current program, which is collaboration between Behavioral Health and Recovery Services, the Probation Department, and Superior Court, meets all of the required criteria to maintain this funding stream.

A portion of the funding is used to enhance efforts to engage offenders by having a Deputy Probation Officer and a Behavioral Health Specialist make direct contact with offenders following sentencing and providing immediate assessments, as appropriate. Currently, for ease of access, the Proposition 36 and Offender Treatment Program offices are located in the Adult Probation Department building across the street from the Courthouse. However, it is estimated that 50% of offenders sentenced to the Proposition 36 program do not appear at the office to schedule an initial appointment.

Furthermore, another significant percentage of offenders do not keep the appointment once it has been scheduled. This results in a violation of probation and a required court appearance.

The balance of the funding will be used, as is available, to enhance treatment options, including expanded residential treatment and Outpatient Services at Stanislaus Recovery Center. Probation has agreed to use the full funding augmentation to support treatment services.

The Department is requesting authorization to accept the additional funding award and increase appropriations and estimated revenues as outlined in the attached Budget Journal. Any additional changes to the budgeted amounts will be returned to the Board for approval.

## **POLICY ISSUE:**

Approval of this agenda item will meet the Board's priorities of a healthy community and effective partnerships by maximizing State funding to expand and enhance current Substance Abuse and Crime Prevention Act programming for individuals ordered to drug treatment.

There is no staffing impact associated with this agenda item.
