Approval to Authorize the Clerk of the Board to Notify the California School Cash Reserve Program Authority to Issue Tax and Revenue Anticipation Notes On Their Own Behalf Page 2

DISCUSSION:

On May 21, 2009, the Board of Supervisors was notified by Piper Jaffray and Company that three school districts subject to the jurisdiction of the Superintendent of Schools of the County of Stanislaus were expected to participate in a cash flow borrowing program whereby the districts would issue tax and revenue anticipation note borrowings. The school districts have pooled their resources and created a joint powers authority designated as the California School Cash Reserve Program Authority for the purpose of issuing one or more series of financing. The districts have requested that your Board notify them that they can issue the borrowing in their own name. The three districts are: Denair Unified School District, Stanislaus Union Elementary School District, and Oakdale Joint Unified School District.

Pursuant to California Government Code Section 53853, your Board of Supervisors has the authority to notify the school districts within a 45 day period that the districts may issue the respective financings in their own name pursuant to subdivision (b) of Section 53853 of the Government Code. In the past, the Board has authorized County staff to notify school districts that they can issue their financings in their own name and staff requests that your Board authorize the Clerk of the Board to do so in this case.

POLICY:

The Board of Supervisors' approval of the staff recommendation is authorized by state law and County staff is not aware of any reason why the Board should not approve this request.

STAFFING IMPACT:

Little or no impact is expected, if the Board adopts the recommendations. However, if your Board does not authorize the recommendation, your Board and County staff would be responsible for numerous actions in conjunction with the issuance of separate tax and revenue anticipation note financing transactions for eleven school districts.
