STAFF RECOMMENDATIONS (Continued):

3. Authorize the submittal of a joint funding request to the California Integrated Waste Management Board for the 15th Cycle Used Oil Recycling Block Grant on behalf of the cities of Hughson, Newman, Oakdale, Patterson, Riverbank, Turlock, and Waterford, and the unincorporated areas of Stanislaus County.

DISCUSSION:

In 1991, the California legislature passed the Oil Recycling Enhancement Act (Assembly Bill 2076, amended in 1992 by Assembly Bill 3073). One element of this legislation created a block grant fund for local jurisdictions to be administered by the California Integrated Waste management Board for the promotion of waste oil recycling. Grants are available to jurisdictions statewide either individually or collectively. Funds for this program are collected locally and returned to the community through this block grant program.

On June 24, 2008, the Board of Supervisors approved a request by the Department of Environmental Resources (Department) to apply for the 14th Cycle grant funds on a regional basis. For the purposes of this Used Oil Recycling Block Grant application (Attachment "A"), the region will include the unincorporated areas of Stanislaus County and the cities of Hughson, Newman, Oakdale, Patterson, Riverbank, Turlock, and Waterford, and letters of support from each of these jurisdictions accompany this report. Stanislaus County has historically taken the lead role in this type of regional grant application and administration.

The amount of the grant award is based, in part, upon a calculation by the California Department of Finance, utilizing their population statistics with a per capita rate of \$0.27. Programs paid for by this grant will help the County and the cities within the regional group in meeting the goals and objectives contained within their Household Hazardous Waste (HHW) Elements such as continuing educational efforts aimed at diverting HHW from the waste stream and expanding used oil recycling opportunities, in particular for auto parts stores. All funding is provided on a reimbursement basis. The term of the grant is for three years, extending from July 1, 2009, through June 30, 2012. After the Department receives confirmation of the grant award, it will return to the Board for authorization to receive the funds.

POLICY ISSUE:

The Board of Supervisors should determine if applying for Used Oil Recycling Block Grant funds from the California Integrated Waste Management Board is consistent with the Board's priorities of a safe community, a healthy community, effective partnerships, and the efficient delivery of public services. Such finding

would assist the County and its partner cities in their effort to increase used oil and filter recycling efforts throughout the County.
