Approval to Introduce and Waive the First Reading of an Ordinance to Amend Chapter 11.08.020 of the Stanislaus County Code Title 11, Amending No Parking Zones on Service Road, Riverside Drive, Fox Road, California Avenue, and Lester Road in the Stanislaus County Unincorporated Areas

DISCUSSION:

The Department of Public Works has received several requests for the installation of No Parking Anytime Zones at several unincorporated areas of the County (Ceres, Modesto, Hughson, and Denair). The following is a summary of the requests received:

<u>Service Road (Ceres area):</u> Gary Caseri, Stanislaus County Agricultural Commissioner, requested a No Parking Anytime Zone along the County property (Stanislaus County Agricultural Center) on Service Road. A farmer who works on the County land notified the Agricultural Commissioner about trucks parking along Service Road hindering farming on this property.

Riverside Drive (Modesto area): The Branch Manager of Aura Hardwoods, Inc., 107 South Riverside Drive, has requested extending the existing No Parking Anytime Zone along the property on Riverside Drive. Vehicles parking in front of the business cause a sight visibility problem for the customers entering and exiting the driveways.

Fox Road (Hughson area): David M. Chase, P.E., City of Hughson Director of Public Works and City Engineer, requested a No Parking Anytime Zone on Fox Road. Vehicles parking on the east side of Fox Road and Euclid Avenue intersection cause a sight visibility problem for vehicles entering the intersection.

<u>California Avenue (West Modesto area):</u> Douglas Fraser, Superintendent of Paradise School District, 3361 California Avenue Modesto requested a No Parking Anytime Zone. Vehicles parked on the north side of California Avenue in front of Paradise School pose a sight visibility problem for motorists entering and exiting their driveways.

<u>Lester Road (Denair area)</u>: Property owner of 3448 Lester Road, Denair requested a No Parking Anytime Zone in front of his property. Vehicles parking on the east side of Lester Road are causing a sight visibility problem at his driveways and parked vehicles block mail delivery. The Department's recommendation was presented to the Denair Municipal Advisory Council during their July 7, 2009 regular meeting for their reference and drew no questions or concerns.

Department of Public Works, Traffic Engineering staff has conducted a study and field reviewed each location. The Department recommends that No Parking Anytime Zones be installed at these locations to help improve traffic safety.

The specific description of the proposed amendment is identified and provided in the text of the proposed ordinance.

POLICY ISSUES:

The Board of Supervisors is asked to determine if this action is consistent with its priorities of providing a safe community, a healthy community, and a well planned infrastructure system. California Vehicle Code 22506 requires Board approval to change parking zones.

STAFFING IMPACT:

The No Parking Anytime signs will be installed by existing Public Works Road Operations staff.

ORDINANCE NO.	C.S.

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING, TITLE 11 CHAPTER 11.08.020 PARKING ZONES ON SERVICE ROAD, RIVERSIDE DRIVE, FOX ROAD, CALIFORNIA AVENUE, AND LESTER ROAD IN THE STANISLAUS COUNTY UNINCORPORATED AREAS

The Board of Supervisors of the County of Stanislaus ordains as follows:

- I. Amend the Stanislaus County Code Title 11, Chapter 11.08.020 (Parking Zone), Subsection 440 (Service Road) and Subsection 423 (Riverside Drive) to read as follows:
- "440. Service Road: On the north side of Service Road from its intersection with Crows Landing Road, to a point 2,130 feet east of the intersection.
- 423. **Riverside Drive:** On the west side of Riverside Drive from its intersection with Nathan Avenue, north to a point 860 feet north of the intersection; and on the west side of Riverside Drive from a point 1,170 feet north of its intersection with Nathan Avenue; north 380 feet, to a point 1,550 feet north of the intersection."
 - II. Amend the Stanislaus County Code Title 11, Chapter 11.08.020 (Parking Zone), to add Subsection 528 (Fox Road), Subsection 529 (California Avenue) and Subsection 530 (Lester Road), as follows:
- "528. Fox Road: On the north side of Fox Road from its intersection with Euclid Avenue to a point 195 feet east of the intersection; and, on the south side of Fox Road from its intersection with Euclid Avenue to a point 160 feet east of the intersection.
- 529. <u>California Avenue</u>: On the north side of California Avenue from a point 430 feet west of its intersection with Pauline Avenue; west 330 feet, to a point 760 feet west of the intersection.
- 530. <u>Lester Road</u>: On the east side of Lester Road from a point 815 feet north of its intersection with Main Street; north 95 feet, to a point 910 feet north of the intersection."
- III. This ordinance shall take effect 30 days after its passage. The ordinance shall be published within 15 days of its passage, with the names of the members voting for and against the same in the Modesto Bee newspaper.
