Approval to Authorize the Auditor-Controller to Establish Interest-Bearing Funds for the Public Works-Lake Road Mitigation and Public Works-Gaffery Road Mitigation

## **DISCUSSION:**

Conditions of approval for Sun Dry Products (Rezone application 2007-04) and Grover Landscaping (Use permit 2006-37), located on Gaffery Road north of the Westley area, and Delaney Aggregates (Use Permit 2008-03), located on Lake Road in the La Grange area, required the payment of a fee of \$.055 per ton of material entering or leaving their respective properties to offset the traffic impacts to County roads.

The requested action will ensure that funds required by the adopted conditions of approval for mitigation of road impacts are set aside and available for transportation improvements within the designated areas. The action also ensures that the related interest will accrue to the fund, to be used for the same purpose.

## **POLICY ISSUES:**

The Board should consider if the recommended actions are consistent with its priorities of providing a safe community, a healthy community and a well-planned infrastructure system.
