

DISCUSSION: Pursuant to California Elections Code 10515 (a) (4), "The election official... shall submit a certificate of these facts to the supervising authority..."

POLICY ISSUE: Pursuant to Election Code 10515 (a) (4), "The county election official ... shall request that the supervising authority, at a regular or special meeting held prior to the Monday before the first Friday in December in which the election is held, appoint to the office or offices the person or persons, if any, who have filed declarations of candidacy. The supervising authority shall make these appointments. (b) If no person has filed a declaration of candidacy for any office, the supervising authority shall appoint any person to the office who is qualified on the date when the election would have been held. The person appointed shall qualify and take office and serve exactly as if elected at a general district election for the office."

DISTRICT SECRETARY'S NOTICE TO COUNTY CLERK (Elections Code Section 10515)

To the County Clerk of Stanislaus County

RECLAMATION DISTRICT 2091 (Name of District)

Pursuant to Section 10515 of the Elections Code you are hereby notified that in the above named district for the general district election to be held on November 3, 2009:

- (A) Whereas only one person has filed a declaration of candidacy for each elective office to be filled, or no one has filed a declaration of candidacy for such offices, and no petition requesting the election be conducted has been filed with the District, no election shall be held for the offices listed below. Request the Board of Supervisors appoint the candidates as indicated prior to December 4, 2009, per Election Code 10515.
