Approval of a Sole-source Purchase of Portable Radios for Local Law Enforcement and the Fire Service with Homeland Security Grant Funding
STAFF RECOMMENDATIONS:
 Authorize the sole-source purchase of portable radios for law enforcement and the fire service with Homeland Security Grant funds.
2. Authorize the Purchasing Agent to issue a purchase order to Motorola in the amount of \$367,936.26.
 Direct the Auditor-Controller to transfer \$369,990 within fixed assets to services and supplies as detailed in the Budget Journal.
FISCAL IMPACT: The total cost to purchase 298 portable radios for 12 fire districts, the Sheriff's Department, Oakdale Police Department and Modesto Police Department command post is \$367,936.26. This funding is included in the Fiscal Year 2008 Homeland Security Grant. The Fiscal Year 2008 Homeland Security Grant was accepted by the Board of Supervisors November 25, 2008.

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DISCUSSION:

This item is submitted to the Board of Supervisors to authorize the purchase of portable radios for the Sheriff's Department, Oakdale Police Department, 12 fire districts and the Modesto Police Department command post. The funding is through the Fiscal Year 2008 (FY08) Homeland Security Grant.

On November 25, 2008, the Board of Supervisors accepted the FY08 Homeland Security Grant. Included in this grant was \$431,648 for the regional interoperable communication project.

On June 30, 2009, the Board approved the application for the Fiscal Year 2009 (FY09) Homeland Security Grant. Within that grant law enforcement and fire representatives identified the significant need for portable radios for first responders. Many of the radios currently used by first responders are so old the radios can no longer be repaired and they are not compliant with the APCO Project 25 (P25) radio standard for Regional Interoperability Communications. Stanislaus County does not have enough portable radios to equip all of its law enforcement and fire first responders. To address this issue, \$505,264 was identified for the purchase of portable radios. Stanislaus County has not received approval for the FY09 Homeland Security Grant. Approval from the State of California is anticipated by October 2, 2009.

Through September 18, 2009, Motorola is offering an \$800 factory discount on the type of portable radios used by the Sheriff's Department, Oakdale Police Department and the fire service. The discount allows Stanislaus County to purchase 173 more radios than anticipated for first responders, for a total of 298 radios. To take advantage of the significant factory discount, the Office of Emergency Services (OES) received approval from the California Emergency Management Agency (Cal EMA) to modify the FY08 Homeland Security Grant allowing the purchase of portable radios in lieu of the equipment for the regional interoperable communication project.

After approval is received from Cal EMA for the FY09 Homeland Security Grant, staff from Stanislaus Regional 911, law enforcement, the fire service and OES will review the Regional Interoperable Communications Project and the continued need for portable radios by first responders and make recommendations for any necessary modifications of the FY09 Homeland Security Grant equipment purchases.

To achieve interoperability and standardize equipment, Cal EMA approved the sole source procurement authorization for purchase of the radios from Motorola. County Counsel and General Services Agency (GSA) Purchasing Division approved the use of a sole source for this purchase. GSA Purchasing concurs that this purchase from Delta Wireless (the only authorized dealer for Motorola radios in this region) is in the best interest of the County, and sees no real competitive advantage to bid this purchase of portable radios.

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POLICY ISSUES:

Acceptance of this grant supports the Board's priorities of *A safe community* and *Effective partnerships* by enhancing the ability of local jurisdictions to prevent, deter, respond to and recover from disaster incidents.

STAFFING IMPACT:

There is no staffing impact associated with this grant.
