Request for Authorization for the Chief Executive Officer to sign an Agreement to Annex with the City of Ceres for the Animal Shelter located on Cornicopia Way in the Ceres Area Page 2

DISCUSSION

On August 4, 2009, the Board of Supervisors approved several matters related to the construction of a new Animal Services Facility to be located in the Buffer of the Stanislaus County Public Safety Center at Crows Landing Road and Cornicopia Way. Part of that approval included an acknowledgement that public water and sewer services would be provided by the City of Ceres.

The City of Ceres concluded that in order to obtain these services, an "Out-of-Boundary" Service Agreement must be approved by the Local Agency Formation Commission (LAFCO). The City of Ceres is prepared to submit an "Out-of-Boundary" Service Agreement application to LAFCO. As part of the application, LAFCO policy requires that an "Agreement to Annex" be signed by the property owner requesting the services.

The County has since the construction of earlier facilities at the site acknowledged that the site will ultimately be annexed into the City of Ceres. The City has requested that the County execute an agreement to annex.

It is recommended that the Chief Executive Officer be authorized to sign an Agreement to Annex with the City of Ceres for the Animal Shelter Facility (See Attachment 1).

STAFFING ISSUES:

Existing County staff is dedicated to working with the partner cities to successfully deliver the new Animal Shelter facility.

POLICY ISSUES:
