Residents in every state of the nation participate in America Recycles Day events. Held annually on November 15th, millions of people become better informed as a result of the national America Recycles Day campaign. The Board of Supervisors has proclaimed November 15th "America Recycles Day" for the past several years.

The Department of Environmental Resources (Department) supports the purpose set forth by America Recycles Day, which is to promote the social, environmental, and economic benefits of recycling and to encourage more people to join the movement toward creating a better natural environment. Departmental outreach efforts encourage individuals, businesses, communities, and government agencies to work together as good stewards of our natural resources.
